- > Dunedin (Albatross colony, Larnachs Castle, Taieri Gorge Train.)
- > Reefton (Westport, Punakaiki, Greymouth.)
- > Westport (Karamea, Old coal mines & historic areas, Punakaiki & Greymouth.)
- > Pelorus Sound. (Havelock North, Pelorus mail boat, Picton/Blenheim.)
- > Molesworth. (Hanmer, drive The Molesworth, Kaikoura.)
- > Nelson/Takaka. (Nelson City, Takaka, Farewell Spit.)

> Wellington. (Activities to be determined. Possibly - Wearable Arts, Te Papa Museum, visit Parliament Buildings, lots of other options.)

3 x nights

> Central Otto (Autumn colours, Visit Wanda, Arrowtown, Queenstown, Cromwell and Alexandra)

> Haast/Central Otago. (Would include travelling through South Westland. The itinerary for this trip to be determined with those interested)

> The Catlins (Longer trip, maybe 4 nights. Again, itinerary to be determined)

I am also looking for other destinations, so if you have any ideas that you think could be worthwhile, I would love to hear them.
